Board of Commissioners Meeting Minutes March 19, 2024

CALL TO ORDER:

1. OFFICER'S REPORTS AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

2. ADMINSTRA TIVE REPORT/SCFD: Chief Teague.

3. FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT - CRESSON: presented by Chief Ron Becker

- o In February 2024, Cresson was dispatched to and responded to 54 calls, down from 68 calls in February 2023. Year to date through two months, Cresson has been dispatched and responded to 143 calls, essentially flat from 2023's 144 calls through February. Of these 54 calls in February 12 were in Parker County ESD 6 area, 1 was in the City of Cresson in Parker County, 5 were in Johnson County, 18 were in Hood County, and 18 were in Tarrant County. Jerad Gomez, Cresson's new Operations Chief, was introduced. Jerad began firefighting as a junior firefighter with Cresson, and subsequently became a Firefighter/ Paramedic with the Euless Fire Department, where he currently serves. An incident where the Parker County ESD 6 provided LifePak 15 monitor/ defibrillator was utilized to defibrillate a patient suffering a cardiac arrest was reviewed, and the ECG strip from the LifePak 15 monitor / defibrillator was shown where the patient was "shocked" and his life saved due to the equipment provided by Parker county ESD 6. Oncor has begun the work to relocate power poles for the Hood County -ARPA funded building addition. The new 4,000-gallon tanker should arrive in Texas from the manufacturing facility in Georgia in a week or so, it's estimated to be a month or so before its delivered and put in service. Total manpower is currently up to 90, which includes 4 on military leave, 1 on family leave, 1 on educational leave, 8 Senior members, and 7 Special members. The remaining 69 members available to respond to calls includes 7 Junior firefighters, 30 Probationary members, and 32 members.
