

Statements required in notice if the proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate and the voter-approval tax rate and the de minimis rate exceeds the voter-approval rate, as prescribed by Tax Code §§26.06(b-1) and 26.063(d).

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

This notice applies to taxing units other than special taxing units or to a municipality with a population of less than 30,000 regardless of whether it is a special taxing unit.

A tax rate of \$ 0.0930 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Parker County ESD No 6

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024-2025 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Parker County ESD No 6 from the same properties in both the 2023-2024 tax year and the 2024-2025 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Parker County ESD No 6 may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for Parker County ESD No 6 exceeds the voter-approval tax rate for Parker County ESD No 6.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for Parker County ESD No 6, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for Parker County ESD No 6.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Parker County ESD No 6 is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024-2025 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 17, 2024 at 6300 Granbury Hwy Weatherford, Texas 76087.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the voter-approval tax rate but not greater than the de minimis rate and does not exceed the rate that allows voters to petition for an election under Section 26.075, Tax Code. If Parker County ESD No 6 adopts the proposed tax rate, Parker County ESD No 6 is not required to hold an election so that the voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate and the qualified voters of the Parker County ESD No 6 may not petition the Parker County ESD No 6 to require an election to be held to determine whether to reduce the proposed tax rate.
